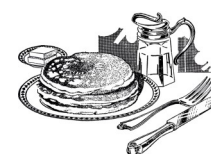


St. John Neumann Retreat Center
