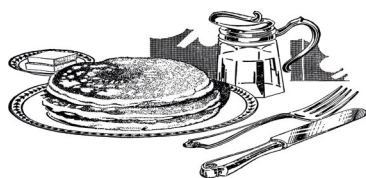
"BABY BOTTLE DRIVE" FOR OPEN DOOR WOMEN'S CLINIC
